



### What is Community Roadwatch?

Community Roadwatch gives you the opportunity to work with local police teams, using speed detection equipment to deter speeding in their area. Speeding drivers are issued warnings via the post. This is proven to reduce speeding on public roads. Residents are unable to volunteer for a Roadwatch on a road near your home.

### Why are we running Community Roadwatch?

Research has shown that speed is often a factor in road collisions, Community Roadwatch is designed to support wider police activities, working with local communities to make people aware of the dangers of travelling too fast on London's roads.
