Upcoming resurfacing work on A127 Southend Arterial Road

I am writing to let you know that shortly we will be carrying out resurfacing works on the A127 Southend Arterial Road. This work is part of our maintenance programme and will improve the condition of the road surface.

The resurfacing work will take place from **14 November to 7 December**. As agreed with the local authority, all site activities will be carried out over-night to lessen the impact on traffic during the day. Works will start **from 21:00 each night and finish at 05:00 the following morning**.

The work will require temporary lane closures and changes to access arrangements to enable contractors to complete the work efficiently and safely.

How our works may affect you

Due to the extent of the work site, it will be necessary to carry out the work over a number of rolling and intermittent road closures. The scheduling of this work and temporary changes will be as follows:

Date and Time	Temporary changes	Diversion route
1 to 7 Dec from 21:00 each night to finish at 05:00 the following morning	Full closure on the A127 eastbound between Squirrels Heath Road and Gallows Corner roundabout. No access to Bryant Avenue from A127	Diversion route is Belgrave Road, Ferguson Avenue, Main Road, Squirrels Heath Road, Gubbins Lane, Colchester Road

*** Pls note there is no access between Grasmere Road and Cornwall Close to the A127. These roads are used as a reference to illustrate the scope of the A127 carriageway resurfacing work.**

Due to the nature of the work, we may need to alter the sequencing of these temporary changes. However, we will ensure advanced warning of changes through Variable Messaging Signs, which will be sited in the area. Outside of the working hours all traffic lanes will operate as normal.

Please be assured we will work to keep noise to a minimum. Noisy works will be completed by midnight to reduce disturbance to residents. We will make every effort to finish the works on time, although poor weather conditions may mean we need to reschedule at short notice.

Pedestrian footpaths will not be impacted during this time and access to properties along the route will be maintained throughout.
